

# S is for Soup. What else starts with the letter S? Can you write them down?







Directions: Draw, color, or paint a picture about:


- 1. The farmers that grow your food.

Directions: Draw a world map of where your food comes from. 1. Start by drawing the places you know in your town, like the supermarket, local farm, or even your own garden.

2. Check the labels of your favorite foods to see what country it's come from and add those to the map.

3. Include all the modes of transportation—like trucks, boats, buses, and trains.

1. Assign parts. (Someone can be Nanni, the grandchild, the

cat, or the gardeners, the merchants, the bus driver—or even the sun, the moon, and the stars!)

2. What's it like to pretend shopping for soup in the supermarket?

3. Make-believe you are in the kitchen making soup.

4. You might tell stories how Nanni learned the recipe from her nanni.

5. When the soup is done, you can pretend to eat it!
